RENEWAL OF USDA COMMODITY APPLICATIONS

The St. John Department of Health & Human Services will be renewing all USDA Commodity Applications for the 2017- 2018 program year. All new applications must be filed before July 28, 2017.

The guidelines for eligible recipients are as follows:

1. An applicant must be a resident of the parish in which the recipient agency has jurisdiction.
2. An applicant must meet one of the following criteria:
 - A. Combined gross income of all persons in applicant's household is within the following Guidelines:

- C. Applicant receives supplemental social security income.
- D. Applicant's household receives general assistance or aid for dependent children.
