**ITEM: RFQ –2019-01 – Low Impact Development Program**

**This addendum is issued to answer Potential Bidders Questions.**

1. I have a question about qualifications. I and my firm have the most extensive green infrastructure and low impact development experience in Louisiana and we are a local firm here in New Orleans. National firms may have more experience, but not in Louisiana. I am a licensed Landscape Architect and Certified Planner and would like to comply with the following requirement by having a local engineering firm with a full-time Registered Professional Civil Engineer on our team. Would this approach meet your qualifications, or does the engineer have to be directly employed by my company?

**Answer:** The Prime Consultant must employ on a full-time basis a minimum of one (1) Registered Professional Civil Engineer registered in the State of Louisiana with a minimum of ten (10) years' verifiable experience in stormwater management experience associated with Green Infrastructure / Low Impact Development. A Prime Consultant who meets these requirements may develop a stronger team and proposal by choosing to enter into sub-contract(s) with firms or individuals from other disciplines, such as Landscape Architecture or Urban Planning.
