ST. JOHN PARISH COMMUNICATIONS DISTRICT AGREEMENT

BEFORE ME, the undersigned Notary Public, duly commissioned and qualified, in and for the Parish of St. John the Baptist, State of Louisiana, and in the presence of the undersigned competent witnesses, personally came and appeared:

St. John the Baptist PARISH PRESIDENT NATALIE ROBOTOM, in her official capacity as the duly elected and authorized representative for the Parish of St. John the Baptist; and

GARYVILLE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, and LAPLACE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, and RESERVE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, ST. JOHN WESTSIDE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT and the ST. JOHN THE BAPTIST PARISH FIRE DEPARTMENT (hereinafter collectively referred to as the FIRE DEPARTMENTS), appearing herein through JOBE BOUCVALT in his official capacity as the St. John the Baptist Parish PUBLIC SAFETY DIRECTOR the authorized representative for the FIRE DEPARTMENTS; and

St. John the Baptist Parish SHERIFF MIKE K. TREGRE, in his official capacity as the duly elected and authorized representative for the St. John the Baptist Parish SHERIFF'S OFFICE.

WHEREAS, the St. John the Baptist Parish Communications District (hereinafter referred to as the "DISTRICT"), being comprised of the St. John the Baptist Parish Sheriff's Office (hereinafter referred to as the "SHERIFF") and St. John the Baptist Parish Council (hereinafter referred to as the "COUNCIL"), and the FIRE DEPARTMENTS, and in light of the fact that the St. John the Baptist Parish Communications District has reached an "end of support" for its two-way radio communications infrastructure. The SHERIFF and COUNCIL and FIRE DEPARTMENTS have decided to enter into an agreement for and on behalf of their respective agencies and in the name of the DISTRICT. Said agreement is formally entitled "INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT" and the parties to said agreement are the aforementioned SHERIFF and COUNCIL and FIRE DEPARTMENTS, along with the Ascension Parish, Communications District. Said agreement having been signed by all three parties on the 8th day of January, 2013.

WHEREAS, the SHERIFF and COUNCIL and FIRE DEPARTMENTS, through their aforementioned duly authorized representatives, do hereby agree to abide by the terms of the INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT they made with the Ascension Parish Communications District, and they do hereby agree to be jointly responsible for their pro rata portions of the aforementioned INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT. The SHERIFF and COUNCIL and FIRE DEPARTMENTS will have allocated to them by the DISTRICT a certain number of two-way radios. The SHERIFF and COUNCIL and FIRE DEPARTMENTS all agree to pay their percentage share of the total amount billed to the DISTRICT by the Ascension Parish Communications District based on the total number of two-way radios allocated to each party for use on the DISTRICT's system.
