WORK AUTHORIZATION NO. 18 (Revision #1)
PERFORMANCE OF SPECIFIC TASKS
DATED January 14, 2014

In accordance with the "Professional Services Agreement" between the Parish of St. John the Baptist, State of Louisiana (OWNER) and Shread-Kuyrkendall & Associates, Inc. (ENGINEER) dated November 22, 1994, the OWNER and ENGINEER agree to the following:

I. The ENGINEER agrees to:

Complete the surveying and design services necessary for the drainage improvements project titled Haydel Canal Crossing Drainage Project Improvements as identified in the attached November 1, 2012 and January 13, 2014 letters.

II. The OWNER agrees to:

Provide information as detailed in Section 3 of the original agreement.

III. Compensation to be paid to the ENGINEER for performing the tasks outlined in Article I above shall be a lump sum of \$19,255.32 for the basic design services (actual design fee will be adjusted based on awarded construction contract) and a not to exceed amount of \$80,514.56 for resident inspection, permitting, surveying and servitude acquisition in accordance with Sections 5.1 and 8.1.5 of the Contract for Engineering Services for these drainage improvements.


Dear Mr. Nunes,

As you are aware, the Haydel Canal project now will require an extensive work effort to resolve the property acquisition issues. Our firm is in the process of completing the design of the project so that we can determine the required drainage servitude across the affected lots. We have attempted to contact all of the affected property owners, however we have encountered some difficulties with some of the properties, and have requested the assistance of the Parish Attorney.

Our original estimate for supplemental services on this project was \$32,500, which included topographic surveys, permitting and servitude acquisition. To date our expenses are over \$40,000, and I expect the work effort for the servitude acquisition will involve much more. Therefore, we would like to request an increase in our supplemental services portion of this project of a not to exceed amount of \$40,000 to compensate us not only for the additional work completed to date, but also for the work effort remaining.

As per your request, transmitted herewith is our proposed Work Authorization for the referenced project. As mentioned in our March 21, 2012 letter to Ms. Robottom, we have estimated the project budget as listed below:


Construction	\$169,800.00
Engineering Fee	\$19,255.32
Topographic Survey	\$10,000.00
Resident Inspection	\$8,014.56
Permitting	\$12,500.00
Servitude Acquisition	\$10,000.00
TOTAL:	\$229,569.88

Please note that we have not included any cost in our project budget for any property acquisition fees. If it becomes necessary to acquire any additional property associated with raising the existing levee, it is our understanding that the Parish will attempt to obtain a servitude from the property owners at no cost.

Also please note that our existing contract for drainage improvements with the Parish was extended earlier this year through December 31, 2012. In order to complete this project under this contract, it will be necessary to extend the contract again. I would recommend a one year extension through December 31, 2013. Apparently, the administration can request that the Parish Council extend the existing contract without the need for another Supplemental Agreement. Please advise me as to how you would like to proceed.

Please review the Work Authorization attached, and if acceptable to you then please forward it to the Parish Council for their approval. Once approved by the Parish Council, please have the Parish President sign both copies and return one to us. The other copy is for the Parish records. If you have any questions or comments regarding this information, please do not hesitate to contact me.
